

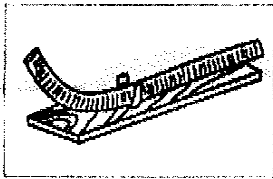
# IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS: READ AND FOLLOW SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- (b) Do not cover this product as the covering may cause the Rope Light to overheat.
- (c) Do not operate with the flexible light tightly coiled around spool.
- (d) Do not puncture, cut, shorten, or splice the Rope Light unless marked with cutting point.
- (e) Do not route the cord or flexible lighting cable through walls, doors, windows or any like part of the building structure.
- (f) Do not use if there is any damage to the light or cord insulation. Inspect periodically.
- (g) Do not submerge flexible light in liquids, or use the product in the vicinity of standing water or other liquids.
- (h) Secure Rope Light cable using only clips provided. Do not secure this product with staples, nails, or like means that may damage the insulation.
- (i) Do not subject flexible lighting to continuous flexing.

**WARNING:** When using outdoor use portable lighting product, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of electric Shock, and personal Injury, Including the following Read All Instructions

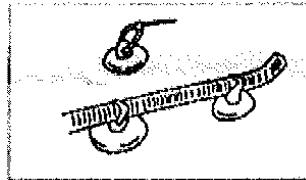
- (a) Ground Fault. Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protection should be provided on the circuits or outlet to be used for the outdoor use flexible lighting product. Receptacles are available having built-in GFCI protection for this measure of safety.
- (b) For outdoor use, use only outdoor rated extension cords.

## USAGE OF ROPE LIGHT ACCESSORIES



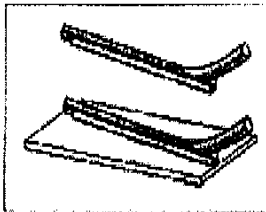
A. With mounting clip (knock the nail into the board surface)

- (1) Use a nail to fix the mounting clip;
- (2) Press the Rope Light into the mounting clip.



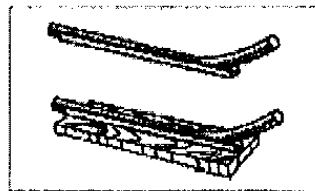
B. With suction cups On the surface of glass or ceramic tile;

- (1) Press the suction cup on a glass surface or ceramic tile with glass pattern;
- (2) Fix the Rope Light on the suction cup with mounting clip.



C. With Channel On glass or other surface:

- (1) Glue the channel on the glass surface;
- (2) Press the Rope Light in the channel.



D. With Channel On the surface of wooden material

- (1) Fix the channel with nails;
- (2) Press the Rope Light in the channel
